


2022-23 experienced a significant housing crisis, as evidenced by the frequent appearance of housing search terms in the Top 20 – appearing nine times compared to utility assistance, which appears three times. Housing needs include financial aid for rent, mortgage, shelter, and homelessness services.

All the Top 20 requested services have a referral success rate of over 80%, with three below 90%. The coverage rate does not directly impact the success rate of referrals. Some services with the least coverage have some of the highest success rates.

## **Report Notes:**

- 1. Homeless Services is a new search term unavailable for 2021-22.
- 2. 211 Virginia Community Resource Specialists provide an average of three referrals per need.
- 3. Keywords are the search terms that Community Resource Specialists use to respond to inquirer requests. These terms are also available on the guided search at www.211virginia .org.
- 4. Basic Needs include food, housing, material goods, transportation, and utilities for individuals.
- 5. Program listings with a statewide service area are not included in the coverage count for Virginia's 133 independent cities and counties.
